About Dr. Guyatt

Dr. Guyatt is a Distinguished Professor in the Departments of Medicine and Health Research Methods, Evidence, and Impact (HEI) at McMaster University.

Coining the term 'evidence-based medicine' in 1991, he has published over 1,000 papers in peer-reviewed journals, his work having been cited over 90,000 times.

Dr. Guyatt played a major role in the creation and refinement of the GRADE approach to rating quality of evidence and grading strength of recommendations in systematic reviews and clinical practice guidelines.

In 2011, Dr. Guyatt received Canada's highest award for civilians, an Officer of the Order of Canada, and in 2013 was chosen as the Canadian Institute for Health Research Researcher of the Year.

Dr. Guyatt serves on the advisory board of UpToDate, and is lead author of *Users' Guides to the Medical Literature*, the definitive textbook on Evidence-Based Medicine. His current clinical and didactic work includes hospitalist coverage and teaching medical residents.
