Thank you for receiving care at Kittitas Valley Healthcare’s Urgent Care.

The Urgent Care Clinic is a hospital based urgent care; the clinic is an extension of the hospital. Every visit will include charges for a facility fee and professional fee. Visits may also include charges for lab and x-ray services. During your visit at Kittitas Valley Healthcare Urgent Care, your provider will order services to determine a diagnosis and appropriate care for your visit. Every individual’s visit is unique so we can only give estimates of charge levels prior to receiving care. Below is an estimate of these fees.
