STRONGER TOGETHER

2020 was a year of incredible accomplishments. Through your generosity and compassion, The Foundation was able to distribute \$302,562 in funding to Kittitas Valley Healthcare, the largest charitable distribution given to KVH in the Foundation's history.

Funding for 2020 included four state-of-the-art 4D surgical towers to enhance our surgical services, four iSTAT machines for rapid cardiac testing, PAPRs to protect our providers on the frontlines of COVID, blood pressure cuffs for use in the Family Birthing Place and COVID masks for children in the community.

Community support has always made us stronger. The need for charitable contributions is as great as it's ever been, and the opportunity for meaningful impact is immense. Many thanks to the donors who have been standing with Kittitas Valley Healthcare for years and for the many new donors standing with us today.

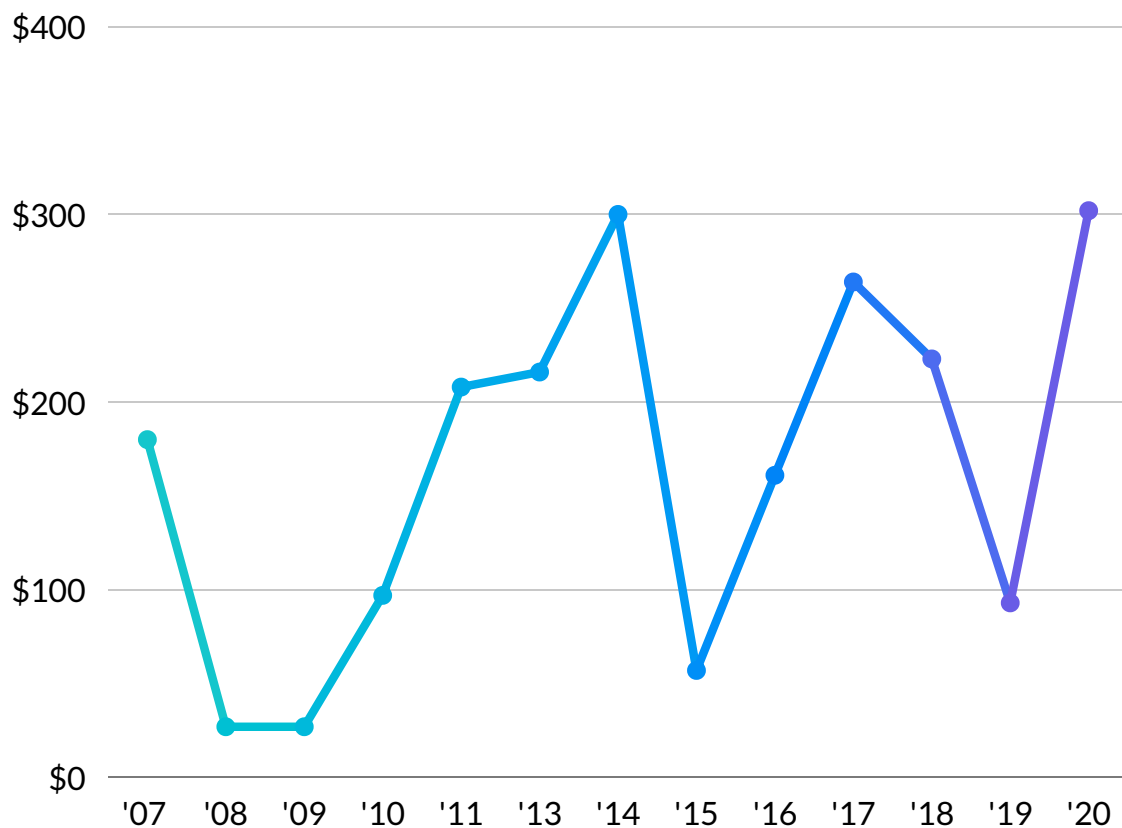
